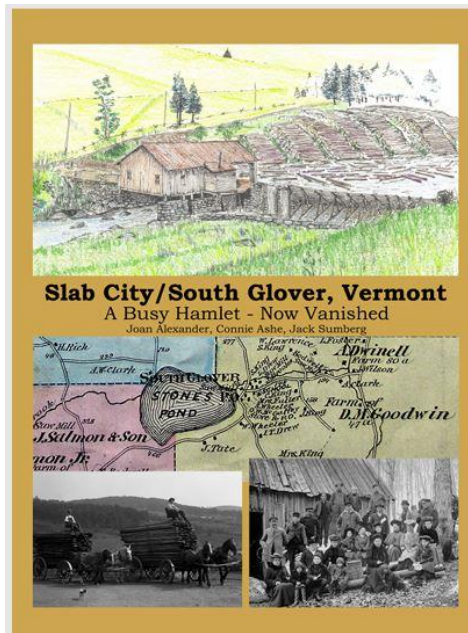


“Slab City” book is about to be reprinted!



The Glover Historical Society is getting ready to reprint their Slab City book, and we'd like to know how many copies to reorder.

Since published in 2016, almost 250 copies of the book have been sold, and it is time for us to reorder as we have hardly any left to sell.

Six years of research resulted in 371 pages that include all we could dig up about Glover's *Slab City/South Glover, Vermont*, including almost 400 images—photographs, maps, documents, drawings—that all help tell the story of this now vanished hamlet that once was a busy community that grew up around the outlet of Stone Pond (Shadow Lake). We have included a comprehensive index, and a fold-out bird's-eye colored map. Publishing and shipping prices have increased since 2016; the book will now be available for \$25 if

you are able to pick your copy up at the Glover Town Clerk's, or if you prefer to have it mailed, \$30.

Published in 2016, we have only a couple of the 250 copies left.
